Andrew E. Gulya, 86, of East Hempfield Township entered into rest on Monday, January 29, 2018 at his residence. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Lola (Morgan) Gulya in 1963, and by his second wife, Esther (Brooks) Gulya in 1990. Born in Bethlehem, PA on December 4, 1931, he was a son of the late Andrew F. and Mary (Kauker) Gulya.

Andrew was a graduate of the Pennsylvania School for the Deaf. He worked at the former KD Tools for 19 years. He was a life member and served 25 years as President of the Lancaster Association of the Deaf; served 14 years as President of the Keystone Senior Citizens for the Deaf; past President of the Central PA Deaf Shuffleboard Association; and former member of the Steel Workers Union.

Andrew was an avid fan of the Phillies, Eagles, and 76'ers.

He is survived by two daughters, Brenda J. Stansbury, and Sharon M. wife of John B. Herr; three grandchildren, Andrew, Christopher and Anthony Stansbury; and five great-grandchildren.

He was also preceded in death by his sister, Dorothy and his brother, William.
