Andrew R. Yerman, 77, of Lancaster, beloved husband, father and grandfather, died Sunday, August 5, 2012 at Hospice & Community Care in Lancaster. Born in Brooklyn, NY, he was the son of the late Arnold and Dorothy Virshup Yerman and was the husband of Alice E. Yerman with whom he celebrated 50 years of marriage.

Andy received a Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering from West Virginia University and worked for the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation for 32 years, retiring in 1996. He served in the U.S. Army during the end of the Korean War.

He was a member of Temple Shaarai Shomayim, Lancaster, where he participated in the Social Action Committee and the winter shelter for the homeless program. He also volunteered for Hospice of Lancaster County, Lancaster General Hospital, 1st grade at Ross Elementary School, and Grace Lutheran Church Community Meal. Along with his wife, they were awarded the "Volunteer Couple of the Year for Jewish Family Service." In his spare time, he enjoyed gardening and puzzles.
