Anne Swank Deavel, 83, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Monday, September 10, 2018 at Calvary Homes, where she resided. Anne was born in Lancaster, the daughter of the late Scott Bennett Swank and Frances Emma (Boyd) Swank. Her husband, R. Phil Deavel, passed away in 2013.

Anne was a graduate of East Lampeter High School (Class of 1952), the Lancaster General Hospital School of Nursing, the Moody Bible Institute (Class of 1958), and the Johns Hopkins Program in Midwifery. She served as a missionary midwife in North Africa before returning to Pennsylvania. She held a variety of nursing positions at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania until her retirement in 2001.
