Barry C. Kriner, 70, of Lancaster, passed away peacefully on Sunday, September 3, 2017, at Hospice and Community Care in Mount Joy, surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Columbia, PA, he was the loving husband of Marlane Henly Kriner and they would be celebrating their 11th anniversary on October 7, 2017. Barry's first wife, Gloria Mattern Kriner passed away in 2004. He is the son of the late Charles E. and Ruth M. Bachman Kriner.

Barry graduated from Franklin and Marshall College with a Bachelor's Degree in Business. He was an active member of his church, St. Leo The Great Catholic Church, where he served as a catechist. He taught 6th graders at the Parish School of Religion. He served on the RCIA team and as an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion.

Barry worked for Armstrong World Industries where he retired as an Industrial Relations Manager.
