I miss her. Sending hugs to each of you.

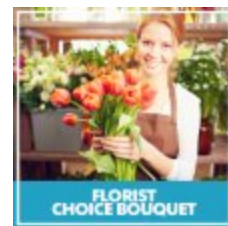
