Clarence Robert Swinehart, 83, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Friday morning, January 8, 2016 at the Hamilton Arms Nursing & Rehabilitation Center following a long illness. Born in Christiana, PA he was the son of the late Charles and Lillian Bullock Swinehart and was raised by his grandmother Ella Swinehart and his uncle Clarence B. Swinehart. Clarence was the husband of Doris Schlotzhauer Swinehart, together they celebrated their 62nd wedding anniversary on January 3rd.
