Dale Allen Snyder, 55, of Lancaster, PA passed away peacefully at home surrounded by family and friends on Monday, June 19, 2017 after a courageous fight. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late Larry Dale and Lurinda Gross Snyder of Lititz and the husband of his beloved wife, Sharon Galen Snyder of 35 years.

He graduated from J.P. McCaskey in 1980 and worked for RR Donnelly and Sons as a machine operator in the printing department retiring after of 30 years of service.

He played in the Chestnut Street, Street Hockey club and co-ed softball league at Lancaster Rec and was an avid Indianapolis, formerly Baltimore Colts fan. He enjoyed golfing, loved his dogs, and porch coffee time. Hobbies included fishing at Bethany Beach, bowling at Garden Spot Bowling Center and attending his daughter's soccer games.

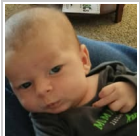
