Daryl J. Evans, 73, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Friday, March 31, 2023 at Temple University Hospital, Philadelphia, PA.

Born in Lampeter, PA, he was the husband of Donna L. King Evans and they celebrated their 52nd wedding anniversary on July 11th. He was the son of the late Robert and Dorothy Arment Evans.

After receiving his Associate's Degree, Daryl worked as a carpenter for R.S. Noonan in Lancaster then Wohlsen Construction, working his way up to Senior Vice President, retiring in 2015. Daryl had many interests including being a Harley Davidson enthusiast, purchasing his first motorcycle in 1994. He and Donna traveled all over the country with their motorcycles.
