Dennis M. Remley, 72, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Wednesday, November 8, 2017 at Hospice & Community Care, Mount Joy. A lifelong resident of Lancaster, he was the son of the late J. Frank, Jr. and Ruth Kirchner Remley. He was married and dedicated to Edith Laiva Remley for more than 46 years.

Denny graduated from McCaskey High School in 1963 and enlisted in the Army Reserves from 1966 to 1972. He received his Bachelor's of Science Degree from Millersville University in 1971. He was mainly employed by IDenticard Systems Incorporated specializing in the field of security and access control sales until his retirement.

He was a very active member of St. James Episcopal Church where he served as a Vestryman and oversaw many of their charitable events.

Additionally, he was active in various other civic organizations; his memberships included, the Sertoma Club of Lancaster, Free and Accepted Mason Lodge #43, Amvets Post 19, Lancaster Leiderkrantz, the American Legion Post 34, Boy Scout Troop #99, and the Union Fire Company #1.
