Dennis L. "Denny" Williamson, 70, of Lancaster, PA, passed away unexpectedly after a brief illness on Saturday, September 2, 2023 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Lancaster, Denny was raised by the late Stan and Joan (Haselwander) Lahr. He was married to his wife Judy (Moyer) Williamson for 45 years.

Denny graduated from J.P. McCaskey High School in 1971, and then received his bachelor's degree from Penn State. He dedicated most of his life to the electrical industry where he worked for fifty years, between Armstrong World Industries and Liberty Place.

Denny, known as the "Go To Guy" had a servant nature and a giving heart; he used his skills to help others and always went above and beyond in doing so. This spirit was positively felt with his children, his church, and his workplace.

Many people including his first love, his grandchildren, referred to him as "Pop". He loved going on beach vacations, dining out with friends and family, walking in the woods, hiking, picnics, and 4th of July fireworks. He enjoyed planting trees and landscaping around the home.
