She lit up any room she walked into, a character, very funny, amicable, helpful, she was able to make friends everywhere, she was the light of the party. Diana was loved by many people. You could find her anywhere on her scooter, downtown, shopping at the mall, at casinos, at bingo with her daughter-in-law Andrea, but most importantly she loved spending time with her kids. She was both a mother and father figure to both her children. She never shied away from showing them off and expressing how proud she was of their accomplishments. She was their saint.
