Donald C. Hagen, 88, of Lancaster, PA, died unexpectedly on Monday, August 19, 2013 at his home. Born in Lancaster he was the son of the late Kathryn Pinkerton Hagen, and husband of the late Winifred "Winnie" A. Murphy Hagen with whom he was married to fifty-four years.

Donald was a student at JP McCaskey High School, Class of 1942 and served four years with the U.S. Marine Corps in the Pacific during WWII reaching the rank of Corporal. He retired from Lancaster Press as a book binder after 20 years of service. He was a long standing member of Christ Lutheran Church, the American Legion Post #34 and Newmanstown Social Club.

He is survived by four children: son Kenneth Hagen, husband of Joan, of West Chester, PA, daughter Patricia Hagen of Columbia, PA, son Michael Hagen, husband of Carol, of Allentown, PA, son Casey Hagen, husband of Patti, of Lancaster, PA.
