Doris B. Strebel, 91, of Lancaster, PA, passed away unexpectedly at Lancaster General Hospital on Wednesday, September 25, 2019. Born in Brooklyn, New York, she was the widow of Rev. Eugene K. Strebel, who died on March 14, 1988. She was the daughter of the late Joseph and Henrietta Wiedieg Bell.
