Dorothy J. Edwards, 97, of Lancaster, PA, died at Maple Farms Nursing Center in Akron, PA, on Saturday, December 10, 2016. Born in Lancaster, she was the daughter of the late Harry W. and Dorothy Reardon Kulp and the wife of the late William A. Edwards.

Dorothy graduated from Manheim Township High School, Beaver College in Jenkintown, PA, and attended Hood College in Frederick, MD.

Dorothy was a lifetime member of St. James Episcopal Church in Lancaster, where she had been active with the church's Alter Guild, Dorcas Group and Ecclesiastical Embroidery Group. She was a former member of the Embroiders Guild, several book clubs, the Lancaster Towne Club, the Iris Club and the Lancaster Country Club.

She traveled extensively in Europe, both with embroidery groups and groups from St. James, sometimes accompanied by daughters and grandchildren.

Dorothy enjoyed sports, competing in swimming and archery in her younger years, and won the Women's National Archery Championship when she was a teenager. She also enjoyed playing golf and watching sports. She was an accomplished musician and played in a quartet of young women. Dorothy also enjoyed word puzzles.

Dorothy loved her family dearly, as they loved her. She is survived by five daughters: Jane E. Dean, wife of Robert C., Lincoln, DE; Susan V. Edwards, Thorndale, PA; Nancy E. Michalec, wife of Michael, Marietta, PA; Andrea L. McGhee, wife of W. Vance, Columbia, PA; and Laurie E. Mallon, wife of Daniel, Malvern, PA; seven grandchildren, four great grandchildren, as well as two step-grandchildren, and two step-great-grandchildren. In addition, she is survived by her brother, Harry R. Kulp, husband of Jane, Lancaster, PA.
