Dorothy J. "Dotty" Shaub Huber, 93, of Lancaster, PA, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 9, 2023 at Penn Medicine Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Martic Township, Dotty was the daughter of the late Clarence and Marian Tomlinson Shaub. She was married to the late Elmer W. Huber, who passed away on December 14, 1989. Many will remember that Mr. Huber owned and operated Huber's Dairy in Marticville, PA.

Dotty graduated from the former Manor Millersville High School, Class of 1947. Following graduation, she worked as a Secretary at Franklin & Marshall College and Lancaster General Hospital in the Heart Department as a Medical Secretary and Technician. While raising her children, she became a full-time homemaker. Years later, Dotty worked as a Secretary at Penn Manor School District. Following retirement, she worked part-time in a sales capacity at the former Weddings by Paulette in Millersville. She enjoyed life and was very much a people-oriented person. She loved family, and friends, traveling, going to musicals, and helping others.

Dotty was a member of Marticville United Methodist Church for many years, the United Methodist Women, and in earlier years, served on various committees. Following the death of her husband, she became a Hospice & Community Care volunteer.

She is survived by her two children, Joni Sonefeld, Lancaster, PA and Mitchell, husband of Anne Huber, Holtwood; two grandchildren, Andrew of New York, and Philip of Lancaster. She was preceded in death by four brothers and three sisters.
