Dorothy W. "Dot" Tase, 98, formerly of Bronxville, NY, and Lancaster, PA, passed away peacefully on Monday, March 14, 2016 at Garden Spot Village, New Holland, PA.

She was preceded in death by the love of her life, Frederick W. Tase, in 1995 after 54 years of marriage. Dorothy, or Dot as she was known by many, was a beloved and caring wife, mother, grandmother, sister, teacher, and friend.

Dorothy was born in Baltimore, MD, daughter of the late Mary Ellen Helt and Samuel White. She graduated from National College of Education, (now National Louis University) Chicago, IL in 1940. Dorothy was an exceptional and devoted elementary school teacher for over 40 years, in Illinois, Connecticut, and New York, influencing the lives of hundreds of children. She loved "her kids" and they loved her back. Dot was an active volunteer in all of these communities, and was still volunteering at Fritz Elementary School, Lancaster, until she was 90.
