His time at Franklin & Marshall preceded a permanent move to Lancaster where he first worked as a taxi driver, a fact that was not lost on anyone who shared the passenger seat with him.

Doug later entered the real estate industry as a salesperson in 1979. Soon after, he became a partner in Concept 100 Real Estate, a company that, through several successful mergers throughout South Central Pennsylvania and the Greater Baltimore Area grew to be Berkshire Hathaway HomeServices Homesale Realty.
