Elaine Carole Kloures Radcliffe, aged 89, passed away on Friday, October 10th, 2025, at Trillium Place in Lancaster, PA. She was the daughter of the late Charles James and Phyllis Huddershaw Kloures of Ambler, PA.

Elaine was a graduate of Ambler High School and Penn State University with a BS and Masters in Music Education and was a member of Alpha Omicron Pi sorority. She was a member of Penn State's freshman honorary and women's music honorary societies and married fellow Penn State Blue Band member Wayne Kistler Radcliffe on June 4th, 1960. They were married for 52 years before Wayne's passing in 2013.

Elaine taught music in both Bucks and Berks County schools and later managed the Mountville Area Library Center for 27 years, coordinating volunteers, encouraging children's reading, and telling stories! She was a founding member of St. Edward's Episcopal Church and its choir and music director from its founding in 1981 until her retirement in 2009. She enjoyed music, theater, entertaining (Charades or Canasta, anyone?), needlework, playing the piano, and, most of all, reading! After retirement, she joined the Mountwaybia Club and remained an active member of the St. Edwards community and the Grande Oak Girls.

Surviving are her children, Scott K. Radcliffe, husband of Marcy H. Radcliffe,

Lancaster, and Michelle (Shelby) K. Radcliffe, Salem, Oregon, and inspiring granddaughters, Phoebe Collier and Charlotte Kistler Radcliffe.

A Celebration of Life with Holy Communion will be held at St. Edward's Episcopal Church, 2453 Harrisburg Pike, Lancaster, PA 17601, on Saturday, October 25, 2025 at 11:00 a.m., with a reception to follow at the Hamilton Club. The family will receive visitors at 10:00 a.m. at the Church until the time of the service. The interment will be private.
