Ethel E. Quigley Rhoads, passed away in her 95th year on Tuesday, June 2, 2015 at Conestoga View. She formerly lived on Maple Avenue in Lancaster.

Born in Mt. Nebo, Lancaster County, she was the daughter of the late John W. and Stella Hickey Erb and the wife of the late Norman Quigley, who died 1962.

She was a graduate of Penn Manor High School, class of 1939. Ethel was of the Methodist faith and at one time sang in the choir at Mt. Nebo United Methodist Church.

Ethel retired in 1989 as the Director of Veteran Affairs in Lancaster following thirteen years of employment. Prior to that she had been employed by Hamilton Watch, RCA and Schick.
