Eunice Arline Brady Spidle, 89, died Thursday July 22, 2010 at Hospice of Lancaster County. She was the wife of the late Charles P. Spidle who died in 1972 and the daughter of the late Solomon Henry and Laura Amanda Shunk Brady. She was born in Middletown, PA on December, 1920 and moved to Lancaster in 1928.

A member of the first class to graduate from J.P. McCaskey High School in 1938, Eunice graduated from St. Joseph's Hospital School of Nursing as an R.N. in 1942 and retired from private duty nursing in 1982. She volunteered for the Red Cross since 1941 and was formerly employed by Crippled Children's Hospital in Elizabethtown, Lancaster Osteopathic Hospital, York Hospital as an O.R. Surgical Supervisor and the Mennonite Home where she was the night supervisor.

She was a charter member of Hempfield United Methodist Church. Her husband owned and operated Spidle's Meat Market in Lancaster for 36 years. She enjoyed caring for her houseplants and raising, breeding, showing and racing Borzoi, Salukis and Whippets.

She is survived by two daughters Karrell Spidle Yeagle of Delaware, Ohio and Kristina, wife of Richard Jumbelick of Lancaster with whom she resided and two sons Terry of Coatesville, PA and Todd, husband of Jo Ann Mast Spidle of Lancaster. In addition to her husband Eunice was preceded in death

by her sister, Ivah Brady Donecker and two brothers Norman and Stanley Brady.
