Evelyn Naomi Conger Hite, 94, formerly of N. Reservoir St. in Lancaster, PA passed away on Saturday, February 3, 2018 in Lancaster. She was born in Kaolin, NV, the daughter of the late Simeon David Conger and Maybelle (Lewis) Conger. Her husband, Earle M. Hite, Jr. died in 1970.

Evelyn retired from The Lancaster County Courthouse as an archivist. She was a life-long member of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, serving in many capacities including 30 years teaching children, president of the women's organization, teaching early morning seminary to high school students, and serving a church mission to Columbia, SC, and a genealogy mission to Salt Lake City. Mrs. Hite completed her own personal history book at 88. She also loved to sew and be with her family. She graduated from Las Vegas High School in 1941.
