Frank Baker Norris Sr, was born in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania to the late Ira Ernest Norris Sr and Henrietta Scott. He passed away on Monday, January 8, 2024, at his home. Frank attended Upper Dublin High School in Fort Washington, Pennsylvania.

Frank served in the United States Army from February 25, 1963, to November 10, 1969, where he fought in the Vietnam War. During his time of service, Frank received several awards: Good Conduct Medal, Meritorious Unit Commendation, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal & Bronze Medal, Combat Infantryman Badge of 1st Award, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Ribbon with Device (1960), and Expert Badge & Auto Rifle Bar & Rifle Bar.

Frank was employed as an Assembly Line Worker at Ford Motor Company in New Holland, PA. He retired in 1999. Following his retirement, he continued to work various part-time jobs in security.

Frank was a member of Bethel African Methodist Episcopal Church in Lancaster, PA, under the leadership of Reverend Edward Bailey, Senior Pastor. He served many years at the Mary Boots and Jean Polite Food Bank in Lancaster, PA.

Frank enjoyed deep sea fishing, poker, caring for his beloved dog, Rocky, and spending time with his family and friends. Frank was well-known in the neighborhood for his generosity and willingness to help those in need. He was affectionally known as the “candy man” because he enjoyed giving candy to the neighborhood's children.

He leaves behind to cherish his memory, his children, Tracey Kendrick, Keya (Mike) Spruill, Leya Ross, Christine Gray, Therese (Christopher) McNeil, Cheryl (Maurice) Allen, Frank Norris Jr.; brother, Bruce Norris, and sister, Evelyn Alexander.
