Frank Pugliese, Jr., 95, of Lancaster, died on Tuesday, July 28, 2015 at Homestead Village. Born in Little Falls, New Jersey he was the son of the late Frank and Concetta Ferrigini Pugliese. Frank was married to the late Theresa Spano Pugliese who died in 2000.
