Garland "Garry" G. Bachman, 82, of Lancaster, passed away at his home on Sunday, June 4, 2017, with his family at his side. Born in Lancaster and a lifelong area resident, he was the son of the late Isaac C. and Eva Way Bachman. Garry was the husband of Gwendolyn H. Sultzbach Bachman. Together they celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary on August 31, 2016. A graduate of J.P. McCaskey High School, he served with the U.S. Navy during the Korean Conflict on board the USS Pilot, AM104, a minesweeping vessel, and then served with the Naval Reserves from 1957 until 1976. He worked for 33 years with the US Postal Service from 1959 until he retired in 1992 as a letter carrier, 26 of those years in the Grandview Heights area, and then for another 12 years, he worked in the mail room of Lancaster General Hospital from 1992 until January 2004. Garry even found time during his mail service career to work part time at Acme Food Store for 25 years.

Garry was a member of Lancaster Church of the Brethren, the National Association of Letter Carriers and the Naval Enlisted Reserve Association. He enjoyed watching and attending sporting events, especially the Phillies, Eagles, Barnstormers and Penn State. His greatest joy was spending time with his family.

Garry will be lovingly remembered by his wife, Gwenn, his children; Denise L. Bachman of Washington, PA, Donna J., (Donald) Templeton and Eric G., (Colleen) Bachman all of Lancaster, his four grandchildren; Kyle R. and Brittany M. Templeton and Cole O. and Faith T. Bachman and his brother
