George L. Haag, 91, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Saturday, February 3, 2018 at Calvary Homes in Lancaster. Born in Flushing, NY, he was the son of the late Edward W. Haag Sr. and May C. (Nickerson) Haag. He was married to Jean A. (Routzahn) Haag for 67 years.

George retired in 1986 from Procter & Gamble after 36 years. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corps during WWII. 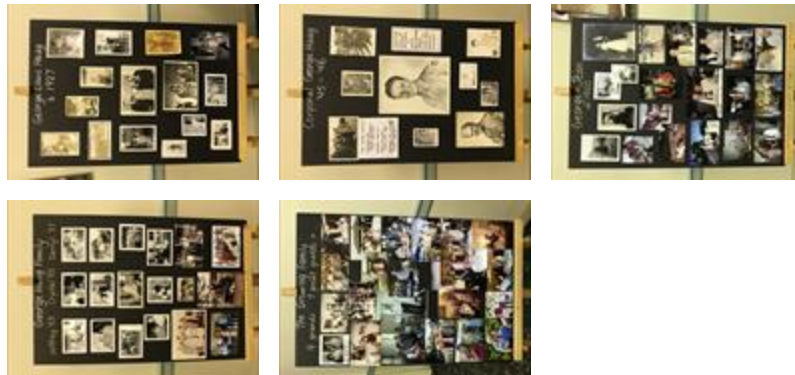
