George Parker Terwilleger, 91, of Willow Street, PA, passed away on Tuesday evening at Willow Valley Lakeside following a brief illness. Born in Englewood, NJ, he was the son of the late Morton and Marie Parker Terwilleger. George was the husband of Kathryn Burgess Terwilleger and together they celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary on September 1, 2014.

George was a 1950 graduate of Marshall University in West Virginia, where he was a member of the Lambda Ki Alpha Fraternity.
