Glenn Roland "Roll" Fadner, Jr., 88, of Landisville, PA entered heaven on July 3, 2015. Born in 1926 as the eldest of five boys in Milwaukee, WI, he was the son of the late Glenn Roland, Sr. and Evelyn (Larson) Fadner, Oshkosh WI. Residing in the Lancaster area for over 60 years, Glenn is survived by his beloved wife of 64 years, Sarah (Bertzfield) Fadner.

Glenn was a graduate of Oshkosh High School and Northwestern University. After serving in the Army Air Corp during WWII, he made his career as an electrical engineer for RCA in Lancaster. He retired his 34 year career in 1985. During his employment with RCA, Glenn received awards for several patents. Glenn served as first adult leader of BSA Explorer Post 41 in Landisville for a number of years and was a founding member of Westgate Baptist Church. At his passing, Glenn was a member of Calvary Church of Lancaster. In his retirement years, Glenn was one of the founders of Lancaster County ACTION, serving faithfully as its treasurer for many years. Additionally, Glenn and Sarah enjoyed the outdoors, traveling across the USA, visiting its many national parks, as well as wintering in Florida.

In addition to his wife Sarah, Glenn is survived by his two children: Glenn R., III, married to Rebecca Fadner of Rochester, NY and Ann (Fadner) Morris of Ephrata.
