Harold L. Mowrer, 90, of Lancaster, PA, died on March 13, 2019 at home after a lengthy and brave battle with COPD. Born in East Lampeter Township, Harold was the son of the late Jacob M. and Annie (Graham) Mowrer. His wife of 42 years, Jane E. Andre Mowrer, died on February 18, 1994.

A US Army Veteran of 30 years, he served with the 11th Airborne Division from 1946-1948 in Japan. He served with the 40th Infantry Division in The Korean War from 1952-1953, The Vietnam War and with the 5th Special Forces, (Green Berets). His last military assignment was with the Military District of Washington, Washington, DC.

He was a Life Member of the VFW, Post 1690, Lancaster, PA and a member of The Special Forces Association, Fayetteville, NC, and a recipient of many awards and decorations. His military service began in 1946 and he retirement in 1975. Harold was a qualified Parachutist and Gliderman. He was of the Protestant Faith.

Harold is survived by nieces and nephews; Jean Wuischpard, Sandra Erb, James Erb, Linda Nuss, and Ted Mowrer and was preceded in death by sisters Catherine Mowrer, Hilda Hershey, and Sara Erb and brothers Musser Mowrer and Hiram Mowrer.
