Harris C. Arnold, Jr., 81, of Lancaster, PA died at Hospice and Community Care, Mt. Joy on Saturday, May 3, 2014. Born in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Harris C. and Helen Trescher Arnold and was married to Julia Merriwether “Judy” Arnold with whom he celebrated thirty years of marriage in August and previously married to Rebecca Bumsted.

He was a graduate of George School, Haverford College and University of PA Law School, and JAG School at the University of Virginia, and later joined the U.S. Army. Harris served as an Attorney for Arnold, Byer and Homsher and as legal counsel of State Colleges of PA.
