Howard R. Grumbrecht, 92, of Lancaster died Saturday morning, November 17, 2012 at his residence. Born in Neffsville he was the son of the late Frank L. and Gertrude V. Wagaman Grumbrecht and the husband of the late Winifred O. Graver Grumbrecht.

He was a decorated Veteran of the Army Air Corps in World War II, serving in the European Theater. He retired from the United States Postal Service as the Director of Finance for the Lancaster Sectional Center in 1979.

Howard especially enjoyed his family, spending time with his grandchildren and their special vacations.

He served on the Board of Directors of The Salvation Army, served on the Advisory Board of the Lancaster Recreation Commission, served in the Boy Scout Commission for many years and was active in numerous civic and service organizations. He holds a life membership in American Legion Post # 34 in Lancaster, Veterans of Foreign Wars # 7294, Millersville and also was a member of Lamberton Lodge # 476 F&AM.

He is survived by three sons Howard R. husband of Sandra (Cameron) Grumbrecht of Lititz, Peter D. husband of Jennifer (Kruppednbach) Grumbrecht of Holtwood and Alex W. husband of Genevieve (Cramer)

Grumbrecht of Lancaster. Also surviving are nine grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren. In addition to his parents and wife he was preceded in death by his brother Frank Grumbrecht and his sister Yvon Sweet.
