Howard Thomas Oblender, 93, of Lancaster, formerly of Willow Street, died on Wednesday, June 19, 2013 at Moravian Manor. Born in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late Howard Edward and Hazel Withers Oblender. He was the husband of Norma Constantine Oblender with whom he celebrated 70 years of marriage.

Howard graduated from J.P. McCaskey High School and later served in the U.S. Air Force from 1942 to 1945 during WWII in the China-Burma-India Theater. He worked in the auto industry for Wiggins, Murphy and later Faulkner Chevrolet, retiring at the age of 91. He was a member of Emmanuel Lutheran Church in Lancaster, the Willow Street Lions, and Meadia Heights Golf Club.

He is survived by a daughter, Nancy, wife of John Werner, of Lancaster, PA; a son, Thomas Oblender, husband of Christine, of Lititz, PA; a daughter, Shelly, wife of Steve Hampton, of Dover, DE; eight grandchildren and 13 great-grandchildren.
