Ida (Billie) Louise Wolf, 96, of Lancaster, passed peacefully, Wednesday, August, 17, 2016, at the home of her granddaughter on a beautiful summer day, knowing that she was surrounded by love after living a long and happy life that impacted thousands of lives in a positive way. Born in Marietta, PA, December 5, 1919, she was the daughter of the late George D. and Effie Shank Billett.

She wed the love of her life, Ralph F. Wolf, on Valentine's Day, 1940 and they shared 71 magical years of marriage together until his death in 2011. She is survived by a daughter, Billie Louise Ruff, a grandson, Jay Wolf (Las Vegas, NV), a granddaughter, Billie-Jayne Cooke (Wess Cooke), and 5 great grandsons: Vincent, Anthony, Joseph, and Dominic Dastra and Wesley Cooke, her sister, Gloria Billett and many nieces, nephews, cousins, and one very special nephew, Ralph Peelor. She was preceded in death by nine siblings.

Billie was a graduate of Millersville State College (now Millersville University) with a degree in education. Over the years she held many jobs, before becoming a successful business woman when she founded the Billie-Ettes baton twirling group. They held national championship titles for 17 years straight and performed all over the east coast. She had over 300 students a week for many years and positively impacted the lives of thousands of people over the years with care and commitment to her students. She also was involved in the band fronts for both Lancaster Catholic and JP McCaskey.

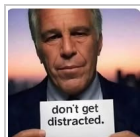
