He cared very much for his family and is survived by his mother, Trina Kunzler; his father, Mike Zimmerman; his two older brothers, Nickolas and Lance Miller; sisters, Krystle and Karli Kunzler; and his long-term girlfriend, Alyssa Bresch. He was loved fiercely by family and friends and will be greatly missed.

He talked often about owning his own shop someday, fixing and selling diesel trucks. He loved the outdoors and trips to the mountains. He killed his first rattlesnake with his stepfather, John at the mountains and it's still mounted in his room. He and his dad would often take snowmobiling, four-wheeling and razor trips in Northern PA and Upstate NY. He enjoyed boating with his brothers but would choose the mountains over the beach any day.

He wasn't very fond of school, although he got good grades. He wanted to be like his older brothers and not have to go to school anymore. However, in high school, he got involved in the CTC for auto/diesel-mechanics program and enjoyed it.

After school, he worked at Diesel and Automotive Services, LLC in Brownstown, PA, where the owner, Gregg Fenicle took him under his wing

and taught him the trade. He went on to work with his father at City Brick Restorations, restoring brick buildings around Lancaster City for two years. However, his passion for wrenching on diesel pick-ups brought him to DirtyDiesels in Birdsboro, PA, owned by Josh Collester, where he worked with a great group of guys who say that they loved Jagur's wit, humor and presence and it won't be the same without him.

Jagur was loved by all. He had a beautiful smile. He was a natural on a Harley and spent countless weekends riding with his best friend Matt and many others throughout the years.

Shooting pool, Bainbridge Inn, campfires, Frogtown, family get-togethers, holidays, Alyssa, their dog Zaya, and big breakfasts were some of Jagur's favorites.

Jagur was not much of a talker until the conversation turned to one of his passions. Then you would have a hard time shutting him up.
