James F. Weaver, 91, of Lancaster died on Friday, November 23, 2012 at the Mennonite Home, Lancaster. He was born July 17, 1921 in Bird-in-Hand to the late John H. and Ida Mae Fisher Weaver. He and his wife Sarah Hanna Weaver celebrated 65 Yrs of marriage.

He attended a Bird-in-Hand one room school and graduated from East Lampeter High School in 1940. He was a former member of Bird-in-Hand United Methodist Church and later a charter member of Faith E.C. Church.

James served in World War II, 77th Infantry division from Nov. 1942 to Jan. 1946. Two years in the South Pacific: Guam, Leyte, Ie Shima and Okinawa. He was awarded the Bronze Star. He worked in the composing room for the Lancaster Newspapers, Inc. and retired after 25 years. He was a member of American Legion Post 34, and had a stand of antiques and collectibles at the former Meadowbrook Market. He loved flowers and gardening.

He was proud of his beloved family and the closeness they always had. In addition to his wife Sarah, James is survived by his daughter Dawn Ziegler of Lancaster, grandson James R. husband of Christina Border Saurbaugh of Lancaster, granddaughter Jennifer wife of Ronald Grube of Cleona, PA, grandson Mike Ziegler of Ephrata and four great-granddaughters. He was preceded in death by his two sisters and six brothers.
