Jean Elizabeth Slover, 94, of The Glen at Willow Valley Communities, passed away peacefully

Born in Paradise, PA, she graduated from McCaskey High School in the mid-year class of 1940 where she was a member of the national Honor Society, stage band, orchestra, and Quill and Scroll. She was employed in the offices of the originally titled Armstrong Cork Company and later by the Lancaster Recreation Commission serving with the Happy Hours, a Senior Citizen Club. Jean was a lifelong member of Otterbein United Methodist Church where she was involved in teaching Sunday school, Vacation Bible School, and with community outreach. As one of the original residents of the Willow Valley Communities at The Manor, Jean lived there for over 30 years, enjoying the hospitality and care of three of the communities as well as serving on several of the resident-based committees. Always a friend, and willing to help all, she found a place in the hearts of so many residents and staff.

At age 92, she decided to teach herself the Balaliaka. Reading was a great joy that lasted into her final moments while benefiting from the technology of the Kindle large print. Jean was a dog owner/lover who later enjoyed visits by a special K9 family member, happily sharing those therapeutic visits with fellow residents. She was very involved with her family, lending any kind of support and acting as a humble role model.

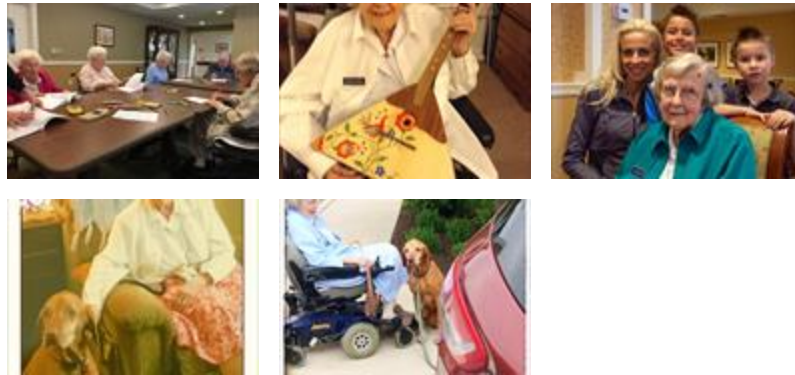
