Jenney L. Miller, 66, of Lancaster, PA, passed away on Thursday, November 16, 2023, at Penn Medicine Lancaster General Health after a short battle with cancer. Jen was an employee at Armstrong World Industries for over 20 years and had planned to retire in April 2024. She had a great love for youth and served as a volunteer at various churches, most recently at Blossom Hill Mennonite where she was a member.

Jen leaves behind her wife and best friend, Christine M. Miller. They shared 25 years and were legally married in 2015.
