Jesse Micah Tedder, 31, of Landisville, PA, went home to be with the Lord following a car accident on January 6, 2018. Born in Dallas, Texas, he was the son of Larry and Tia Walker Tedder, Lancaster, PA. Jesse was a Christian and gave his life to Christ at six years old.

He graduated from Hempfield High School in 2004 where he excelled in football, lacrosse, track and diving. Jesse was also an NCAA Springboard Diver at West Chester University.

Jesse proudly served his country in the United States Navy. After four years of service, he received an Honorable Discharge in 2017. He worked at Arconic as a heavy equipment operator in the Cast House for the past year.

He was a passionate bodybuilder whose enthusiasm and motivation inspired others to reach their full potential. Over the years he could be found at Hempfield Recreation Center and Gold's Gym generously lending his fitness expertise. Whether you were asking for help or needed the encouragement of a coach, he was always there to offer guidance.

He will be remembered for personifying a superhero as much as anyone could. No one can forget a "Jesse Hug" and his ability to see "the glass, not half full, but full to the brim."

In addition to his parents, he is survived by sisters, Anna, wife of Jake Kail, Leola, PA, and Amy Tedder, London, England; his brother, John Tedder of Landisville, PA, his nephew Jude Kail, and niece, Taryn Kail. He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Jesse and Rita Walker and L.V. and Jackie

Tedder.

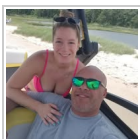

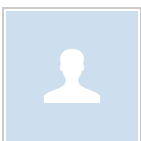
