Jimmie Dee Wilcox Jones, 95, formerly of Clermont Ave., Lancaster, PA, passed away on Monday, April 4, 2016 at Masonic Village of Elizabethtown, PA, Born September 15, 1920, in Eastman, Georgia, she was the daughter of the late Martha Wilcox Alexander and John D. Wilcox and wife of the late Albert Lee Jones, Sr., who passed away on June 11, 2003. They moved from Coatesville, PA to Lancaster in 1955. After working many years as a clerk at Duke Clothiers, Jimmie retired and worked part time for the School District of Lancaster as an aide and retired again. She formerly worked at Warner/Lambert and Schwalm's Watch Dial Factories.

Mrs. Jones was a member of Ebenezer Baptist Church in Lancaster for more than 50 years. While there, she served as a missionary, choir member, pastor's aide, usher and volunteer for the church food pantry. She was a member of Church Women United, Urban League and board member of the Southeast Health Center.

She worked for many years as Judge of Elections for Lancaster City. She enjoyed participating at the Lancaster Neighborhood Senior Center, where she also volunteered as a class leader. She also volunteered for the American Red Cross. Jimmie enjoyed fishing, gardening, traveling, social functions, church and her friends and family.
