Joe Allen Gandy, 89 years, of Millersville died at home on Saturday, May 21, 2011. Born in Richmond, IN he was the son of the late Arthur C. and Nancy Reed Gandy. He was the husband of the late Gene H. Soward Gandy who died in December 2009 and with whom he celebrated 62 years of marriage.

He earned a Bachelor of Science in Forestry degree from Perdue and a Master of Science in Forestry Degree from Duke University. In between, Joe served in the US Marine Corp and was honorably discharged as a 1st Lieutenant. He worked for Armstrong World Industries from 1946 – 1987 where he was a research scientist in Development for Flooring and Building Products.

Joe was a member of St. James Episcopal Church. He enjoyed his time with his family, gardening and wood-working.

He will be greatly missed by his family, friends and his care-taker Tonya Osborne. He is survived by his nieces and nephews. In addition to his wife Gene he was preceded in death by his daughter Linda Gandy.
