John C. Brower III, affectionately known as Jack, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, April 9, 2025, at his residence at The Lakes at Willow Valley. He was 87 years old.

A man of great integrity, Jack was widely admired as a “giant of a man,” known for his fairness, honesty, and strong moral character.

He was born at Germantown Hospital in Philadelphia to the late John C. Brower, Jr. and Dorothy E. Horsefield, and was raised in the Olney section of the city. Jack graduated from Lincoln High School and went on to serve proudly in the U.S. Army during the Cuban Missile Crisis.

Over the years, he made his home in Warrington, PA, Houston, TX, and Lancaster, PA, before retiring to Willow Valley. Jack enjoyed a long and successful career as a sales manager with Nabisco, where he worked for 35 years before retiring. Jack was a member of the F&AM Lodge 665, Ephrata.

Jack is survived by his beloved wife, Carol J. Brower (nee Wunsch); his devoted daughters, Beth Jean Jennings (Allan Vance) and Heidi Ann Pierce (Samuel Joseph); his cherished grandchildren, Jeremy, Justin, David, Klarissa, and Zachary (Olivia); and his adored great-grandchildren, Justin and Olivia.
