May Jack Rest in Peace in God's Hands.

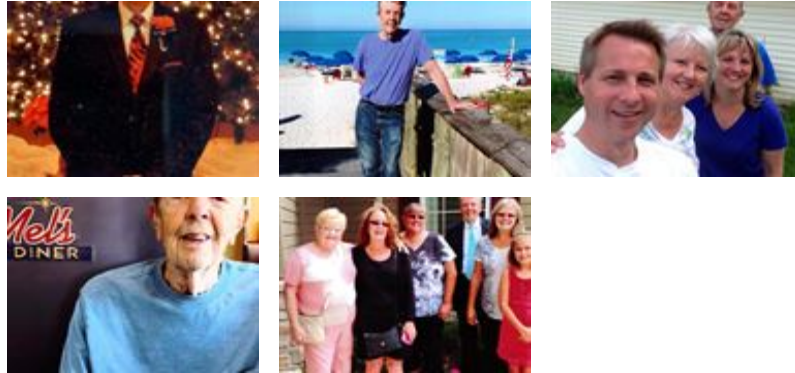
