John S. Kunzler, 56, passed away peacefully on Thursday, July 26, 2018 at home surrounded by family following a brief illness. He was born in Lancaster on October 20, 1961. He was the son of the late Chris Kunzler and Joan S. Kunzler.

John graduated from Lampeter-Strasburg High School. His career at Kunzler and Co. Inc. began with an entry level position and ended as the Executive Vice President of Operations. John's leadership, friendship and wisdom will be missed by his peers.

John was an avid hunter and fisherman whose boat, Chasin Tails, was docked at Sunset Marina in West Ocean City, Maryland and has been seen as far south as Cuba. 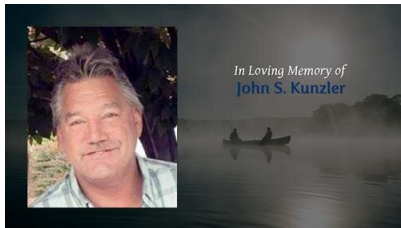
