John E. Logan, 84, of Lancaster died on Monday, April 9, 2018 at Hospice & Community Care in Mount Joy after a brief illness. John was born in Ridley Park, PA on April 2, 1934 to Elmer E. and Miriam A. (Bell) Logan and was the beloved husband of Frances Ann (Reeks) Logan for the past 60 years.

He was employed in corporate management for the former Hercules Corporation (Wilmington, DE) for 30 years, working in 8 locations around the country and retiring in 1990 after a 2 ½ year assignment in Brussels Belgium. He honorably served his country during the Korean Conflict in the US Air Force attaining the rank of Staff Sergeant. John was active in the American Red Cross Organization serving as a board member for the Northern Vermont Chapter, board member and chairman of the Central Vermont Chapter Blood Services unit, and board member of the American Red Cross Disaster Services unit. He and Ann also volunteered with the Red Cross in disaster relief efforts. While in Lancaster he and Ann were members of First United Methodist Church.

Surviving, in addition to his wife Ann, is a daughter, Denise A. Logan and her significant other Mark Lavigne of Essex Junction VT, son, Troy J. Logan married to Bernadette Logan of Paoli, PA, two grandchildren; Matthew and Katherine Logan, and sister-in-law Mary Wheat of Lee Hall, VA.

A memorial service will be held on Saturday, April 21, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. at First United Methodist Church, corner of Duke and Walnut Streets, Lancaster, PA. The family will receive friends at the church from 12 Noon until the time of service.
