John Hill Pinkham, 98, of Willow Valley Lakes Drive, Willow Street, PA, passed away while singing on Sunday, August 28, 2016 at Lakeside of Willow Valley.

Born August 1918 in Ridgefield Park, NJ, he was the husband of Gwendolyn Dunkerton Pinkham. They celebrated their 71st wedding anniversary on October 14, 2015.

He was the son of the late Harold Walter and Alice Hill Pinkham.

“Jack” graduated from New York University with a Bachelor of Science degree in economics. He spent 28 years with Union Carbide as a sales manager and 25 years as owner of Naylor’s Auto Parts.
