John W. Hambright, 82, of Mt. Gretna, PA died at his home on Tuesday, April 2, 2013. Born in Lancaster, PA, he was the son of the late George J., and Maude Wolf Hambright. He was preceded in death by his wife Elizabeth “Betsy” Eckert.
