Joseph Ortega (Joe the Barber), entered into rest to be with his Lord and Savior on Monday, December 17, 2018 in Mechanicsburg PA. He was 79. The son of the late Nicholas and Santos Villegas Ortega, he is survived by his wife of 61 years, Susan J. McComsey Ortega.

Born in Lancaster and formerly of N. Conestoga Drive, Joe went to Lancaster City Schools and graduated from Calmir Barber School in Philadelphia in 1957. He operated Ortega's Barber Shop at 361 E Ross Street, Lancaster PA for 51 years. He enjoyed hunting, fishing and has a camp in Clearfield County, PA. Joe was a member of Bridgeport Mennonite Church for 67 years. He attended Grace Church at Willow Valley until his illness. He most recently attended The Meeting House, Carlisle PA.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by 4 children: Nicholas Ortega (Brenda) of Carlisle PA, Monica Ortega, Lancaster PA, Michael Ortega (Shari), Lancaster PA and Mark Ortega (Brenda) Landisville PA, 9 grandchildren and 14s great-grandchildren.
