Joseph Shulim, 98, of Baltimore, MD died on Saturday, January 27, 2018 at Sinai Hospital in Baltimore Maryland. Born in New Haven, CT he was the son of the late Samuel and Rose Schumach Shulim and was the husband of Blanche Katz Shulim for 62 years.

After finishing high school he served in the US Air Force during World War II as a Plans and Statistics Officer planning for the invasion of Normandy. He received the bronze star medal for his service. Joseph worked for 17 years as a salesman in the New York Life Insurance Company. Blanche and Joseph moved from New York to Lancaster in 1991 and later moved to Baltimore in 2004. He was a volunteer at the Lancaster history.org and Bikur Cholim where he visited the elderly and infirmed. His hobbies included photography, music and architecture.

In addition to his wife, Joseph is survived by his son, Scott husband of Swati Shulim of Lutherville, Maryland. He was preceded in death by a daughter, Robin Shulim who died in 1988 and two sisters: Adele Shulim and Evelyn Rosenberg.

Graveside services were held privately at the New Montefiore Cemetery in Farmingdale, New York.
