Josephine B. "Jo" Good, 90, died Tuesday, November 21, 2017 at Arbor View Willow Valley. Born in Manheim, PA on May 31, 1927, a daughter of the late George and Mabel (Ditzler) Birkenbine, she was preceded in death by her husband of 59 years Dr. Donald Good.
