Judith Ann Ciotola, 69, a resident of Lancaster, died Saturday, July 2, 2011 at Lancaster Regional Medical Center after a brief struggle with cancer.

She was a native of Warsaw, Indiana. The daughter of a U.S. Army officer, she resided in her youth in Austria, Thailand, and Alaska. Judith graduated from Elon College in 1964 with a bachelor of arts in French. She served as secretary of her class at Elon and was a member of Gamma Epsilon sorority. She appeared in "Who's Who Among Students at American Universities and Colleges, 1964-65." Judith pursued graduate studies in French at the University of Indiana.

She was a voracious reader and an appreciator of the fine arts, history, and literature. A lover of cats, she took in strays and contributed to the Humane Society and other animal relief organizations. She enjoyed flower gardening, collecting Pennsylvania German pottery, touring historic homes, vacationing on the Outer Banks in North Carolina, reuniting with her sorority sisters, and spending time with family. She never missed a birthday greeting to those dear to her.

Judith worked as a pre-school teacher in Hartsdale and Brewster, New York, and as a substitute teacher in Lancaster County schools. Later in life she worked for the YWCA of Lancaster and the U.S. Postal Service. She was

postmaster at Talmage, Pennsylvania.

Judith was married to Nicholas P. Ciotola, a classmate at Elon. The marriage ended in 1984. She is survived by her sons, Nicholas P. Ciotola, Jr., of Pittsburgh and Andrew P. Ciotola of Lewisburg; a sister, Paula Everett of Edinburg, Virginia; two brothers, Jeffrey Hudson of Marrietta, and Michael Hudson of Mount Joy; and one grandson. She was preceded in death by her husband and her parents, Paul and Kathryn Hudson of Lancaster.
