Julie Diane Baumbach, of Lebanon, passed away peacefully on Saturday, February 24, 2024 at Hospice of Central PA, “Carolyn’s House”. Born in Lancaster, PA, she was the daughter of Elaine (Jones) Baumbach and Casper “Cap” K. Baumbach Jr.

She graduated from Millersville University in 1995 with a Bachelor’s Degree and her Master’s Degree in 1998 in Education. Julie worked for the Cornwall Lebanon School District at Ebenezer Elementary School for 27 years. During her time at Ebenezer, Julie earned a “Reading Specialist” certificate and English as a second language certificate. Julie’s impact on her students, friends, teammates, and community was one of a kind. She will be dearly missed by her family, friends, and students.
